

IOWA HOME HEALTH DIAGNOSIS CODE SELECTION



Home Health services must include a diagnosis code selection prior to billing. If a diagnosis code is not selected, an **alert** will trigger preventing the visit from being exported.

R7052 - Diagnosis Code is missing.

To select a diagnosis code, navigate to the '**Authorizations**' page in the Carebridge portal. Here, the 'Filters' drop-down menu can be used to locate the desired authorization. Click the '**Actions**' icon (*three vertical dots*) to the right of the authorization row and select '**Authorization Details**'.
