

# CAREBRIDGE PROVIDER PORTAL

## TENNESSEE HOME HEALTH UNIT OVERRIDE GUIDE



Tennessee Providers can override default unit definitions for *Home Health Phase 2* services using the CareBridge portal.

**Note:** Modifying the unit definition will recalculate unit consumption for any unbilled visits according to the effective date. Previously billed visits will need to be re-exported. Be sure to review your rate configuration when adding overrides.

CareBridge and third-party EVV system users can log into the CareBridge Provider Portal, navigate to the **'Settings'** page, and click the *Unit Definitions* tab. All current unit definitions are listed here. To create a new unit definition override, click the *Add Override* button. You can also select the *Actions* menu (three vertical dots) to edit an existing override (Figure 1).

On the *Add Override* pop-up menu, select the payer, service, override, effective start date, and optional expiration date. Carefully review the selections, then click *Submit* (Figure 2).
