Tennessee Providers can override default unit definitions for Home Health Phase 2 services using the CareBridge portal.

Note: Modifying the unit definition will recalculate unit consumption for any unbilled visits according to the effective date. <u>Previously billed visits will need to be re-exported</u>. Be sure to review your rate configuration when adding overrides.

CareBridge and third-party EVV system users can log into the CareBridge Provider Portal, navigate to the '**Settings'** page, and click the *Unit Definitions* tab. All current unit definitions are listed here. To create a new unit definition override, click the *Add Override* button. You can also select the *Actions* menu (three vertical dots) to edit an existing override (Figure 1).
