Good morning,

The Wyoming Department of Health, Division of Healthcare Financing (Division) would like to share a quick update related to the anticipated launch of Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) in Wyoming.

Due to extensions in the timeline for development and testing, the Agency has made the decision to postpone the anticipated launch date for the EVV solution to February 15, 2022. We are continuing to monitor the progress of these activities and will notify our EVV stakeholders if any further delays or adjustments must be made. At this time, the date for required use of the EVV solution will remain set for March 31, 2022.

EVV trainings that were scheduled between February 1, 2022 and February 15, 2022 have been cancelled and will be rescheduled after the system becomes available for use. If you have already registered for training during this timeframe, your registration has been cancelled and new dates will be communicated to you when the updated training schedule has been established.

The Division will continue to provide EVV updates and information via email over the coming weeks as we move into the final phase of implementation. We appreciate your ongoing patience as we strive to bring you an EVV solution that will meet the requirements of the 21st Century Cures act while offering providers a stable and effective way to manage and monitor service delivery.
